just want to thank you for your support over this bill. We were just talking about how we talked about this three years ago. Cool pavement, it's just a topical treatment that you literally paint onto asphalt, and it's going to bring down both the surface temperature of the roads, but also the ambient temperature. It's a cheap, low-fi way to combat extreme heat. Every year, we have about 500 New Yorkers who die from extreme heat-related illnesses, and so this is one of many strategies and tools to use to bring that down. So, I'm really excited about this, and just wanted to thank you, Chair, for your support on it.
