4	Section 576-a (2) of the New York State Private
5	Housing Finance Law provides that a municipality may
6	disclose of a real property to a housing development
7	fund company without public auction or sealed bids
8	subject to certain notice and hearing requirements.
9	Consistent with such law, The Council held its
10	hearing on January 14th, 2019. HPD requests that The
11	Council amend the prior resolution by: adding a
12	paragraph stating, whereas on January 4th, 2019 HPD
13	filed with The Council its letter dated January 4th,
14	2019 requesting approval of the disposition of City
15	owned real property pursuant to 576-a (2) of The
16	Private Housing Finance Law, and deleting a paragraph
17	that refers to Charter Section 197-d, and replacing
18	it with the following new paragraph: Pursuant to
19	section 197-d of The City Charter and on the bases of
20	the decision and application, and based on the
21	environmental determination and consideration
22	described in the report, C 190051 PPX incorporated by
23	referenced hearing, The Council approved the decision
24	of the City Planning Commission pursuant to section
25	576-a (2) of The Private Housing Finance Law, The
