Created in 2010, The Report and Advisory Board
Review Commission is responsible for reviewing the
continued usefulness of reporting requirements
established by local law. If The Commission
determines that a particular recording requirement is
no longer justified it has the authority to waive the
requirement. Once the commission votes to waive a
report, The City Council may vote to approve or
reject the waiver.

Last December, The Commission voted to waive six different reporting requirements in the City's

2 charter and administrative code. Each of these six

3 requirements are described in detail in The

4 Commissioner's determination letter, which was

5 submitted to The Council on December 30th -- it is

6 attached to today's Committee Report as Exhibit 1.

Last week, The Committee conducted a hearing on The Commissioner's recent waiver determinations to gain additional context for each of the six reports selected for waiver. Today The Committee will vote on the resolution to reject two of these waivers made by The Commission and approve the remaining four.

The Committee will also vote on the companion bill to remove the language from the administrative code and charter that will be nullified upon the passage of the resolution. In passing this resolution and bill, The Committee will allow several updating reporting requirements to be waived while also ensuring that the two important reports continue to be produced.

One report that will be continued to be required is the 911 Operational Time Analysis Report which includes critical information of the police department's response time to 911 calls; the other one is The Annual Youth Services Report which
