CHAIRPERSON LOUIS: Thank you. We have also been joined by Council Member De La Rosa. I now open the public hearing on the pre-considered L.U. related to application number G220013CCQ, the Mount Neboh and Mount Carmel Cemetery merger request, submitted by Mount Carmel Cemetery pursuant to sections 1506C of the New York State Not For Profit corporation law. This application request approval to merger the Mount Carmel Cemetery located at 83-55 Cyprus Hill Street, block 3750, lot 655 with the Mount Neboh Cemetery located at 82-07 Cyprus Hill Street, block 3750, lot 705. The cemeteries are located in the Queens

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Council District represented by Councilmember Holden.
Councilmember Holden, would you like to make any
remarks this morning?

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COUNCILMEMBER HOLDEN: Yes, thank you chair. I support the merger between Mount Carmel Cemetery and Mount Neboh Cemetery in Glendale, which I represent.

Mount Carmel Cemetery has provided services to the Jewish community since 1906, and they are well-positioned to take control over Mount Neboh and ensure the cemetery is well maintained. If it was not for this merger, Mount Neboh would fall into disrepair, so it is a good merger. I applaud Mark Stempa and the rest of Mount Carmel's leadership for leading this effort and insuring the interments at Mount Neboh are cared for. This team worked hard to move this process along as quickly as possible, and I urge my colleagues to vote yes. Thank you chair.

CHAIRPERSON LOUIS: Thank you. We have also been joined by Minority Whip Vernikov. We are joined today by Mark Stempa and Richard Betheil, who will be presenting on behalf of the Mount Carmel Cemetery.

Counsel, please administer the affirmation.

COUNSEL CAMPAGNA: Please state your right hands and state your names.

Mr. Stempa, could you please your right hand and state your name? 6 MARK STEMPA: Mark Stempa. COUNSEL CAMPAGNA: Do you affirm to tell the 8 9 truth, the whole truth, and nothing but the truth in your testimony before this subcommittee and in 10 11 response to all councilmember questions? 12 MARK STEMPA: Yes. COUNSEL CAMPAGNA: Mr. Betheil? Mr. Betheil? 13 14 RICHARD BETHEIL: Yes sir. 15 COUNSEL CAMPAGNA: Thank you. Sir, you may 16 continue with today's agenda. 17 CHAIRPERSON LOUIS: Thank you for joining us this 18 morning. You may all begin. 19 RICHARD BETHEIL: I will be the first speaker for 20 Mount Carmel if that is appropriate at this time. 21 Thank you. First, good morning and thank you for 2.2 hearing this application today. We very much 2.3 appreciate it. My name is Richard Betheil. I am counsel to this cemetery, and I am a partner in the 24

partner in the Pryor Cashman law firm.

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particulars of this transaction are set out in some detail in the February 7, 2022, letter I submitted to the speaker, which constitutes the application.

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As you correctly stated, this is an application to merge 2 cemeteries where a public hearing and council approval are pursuant to not-for-profit corporation section 1506C. As Councilman Holden stated, and we appreciate his support here as well, Mount Carmel has been in operation for more than 100 years, Mount Neboh for longer than that. Mount Neboh unfortunately has fallen into disrepair. It is a corporation that is not meeting statutory requirements in certain respects, and which unfortunately we have experienced substantial issues, including, from time to time, confusion as to burial records, and even lots that have been sold more than once.

Mr. Stempa has been working through these over the last 6 or 7 years, and the fact that the reason why we have been talking about this since 2015 but are only getting to this point today is we have been trying to work out as many of those issues prior to merger as possible. We think the merger is in the best interest of both cemeteries and the Jewish

SUBCOMMITTEE ON LANDMARKS, PUBLIC SITINGS, AND COMMUNITY. We also think that it avoids the city and the state becoming responsible for a cemetery that otherwise would be abandoned. Finally, as I am sure, councilmembers all know, cemeteries in this state are subject to close state regulation. Before we came to this point of seeking The Council's approval, we first needed the approval from the New York State Cemetery Board, which has statutory authority for regulating the operations of all not-for-profit cemeteries.

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I have attached to that February 7th letter to
The Speaker the letter from the Cemetery Board
approving the merger and recommending approval by the
other stakeholders, like The Council, that are
necessary, as well as The Court or the Attorney
General's office. So, we see no reason why any party
would want to oppose this, and we would urge that the
subcommittee approve it, that the full committee
approve it, and that finally that The Council approve
it.

If there are questions, I would be glad to answer them. As you know, Mr. Stempa, the president of Mount Carmel is also present here to answer questions as appropriate. Thank you.
