expense budget. As with all transparency resolutions, Council Members will have to sign a disclosure form indicating whether or not a conflict exists with any of the groups on the attached list. This disclosure form and accompanying instructions were emailed to all Members last night by the Finance Division. If any Council Member has a potential conflict of interest with any of the organizations listed, they have the opportunity to disclose the conflict at the time of their vote. As a reminder, please disclose any conflicts you may have with the proposed subcontractors used by organizations sponsored by discretionary funding. These disclosures must be made before any subcontractor can be approved. Disclosure forms must be completed and submitted prior to the vote on the transparency resolution today, and it may be emailed to Julius Caranda in the General Counsel' office.

We now have 2 budget modifications. The first, a revenue budget mod seeks to appropriate new city revenues in FY-22 in the amount of 1.36 billion. The 1.36 billion of new revenues combined with an adjustment to the general reserve will be used to prepay 1.54 billion of FY-23 expenses in FY-22.

The second, an expense budget mod represents proposed movements of city funds within and among city agencies in FY-22 to implement changes in the city's expense budget but leaves the overall level of city funds unchanged.
