Good morning, and welcome, everybody to today's

Committee on Education vote on Resolution 283-A,

sponsored by Speaker Adams. I am proud to have signed
on to this resolution, as a cosponsor, along with 35

of my colleagues.

Resolution 283-A calls on the Mayor and the Chancellor of the Department of Education (DOE) to immediately reverse the DOE's reductions to school budgets; calling on the Chancellor to submit updated school budgets to the Panel for Educational Policy reflecting the restoration, as well as an accounting of unspent federal stimulus funds; and calling on the

Mayor to promptly utilize any unspent and unallocated federal stimulus or other funds and submit a budget modification to the Council to fully restore the \$469 million removed from school budgets by DOE.

The committee previously heard testimony on Resolution Number 283-A from parents, advocates, and all other interested stakeholders at a hearing on August 22, 2022. At the hearing, we heard from New York City Comptroller, The United Federation of Teachers, and many advocates that the pending cuts to schools are unnecessary due to remaining federal stimulus funds and harmful to our schools and students. More importantly, we heard directly from parents and teachers about the devastating impact that the COVID pandemic had on students' mental health as well as academic performance.

All of the testimony made it abundantly clear that we should not be cutting school budgets at this time. Rather, we should be investing in needed services and support to help students recover from the impact of COVID-19.

As I stated in my opening remarks at the August 22nd hearing, we want to acknowledge that the administration has met with us to negotiate restoring
