I'm Council Member Keith 15 Powers, Chair of the Committee. 16 Before we begin, I'd like to introduce the other Members of the Committee who are present 17 18 here today. We are joined by Speaker Adrienne Adams, 19 Minority Leader Joe Borelli, Justin Brannan, Council 20 Member Gale Brewer, Council Member Selvena Brooks-21 Powers, Council Member Crystal Hudson, Council Member 22 Rafael Salamanca, Council Member Pierina Sanchez. 23 I'd like to acknowledge the Counsel of 24 this Committee, Jeff Campagna, and Committee Staff 25 that worked on the appointments we'll hear today.

1 COMMITTEE ON RULES, PRIVILEGES AND ELECTIONS 3 2 Chief Ethics Counsel Pearl Moore, Director of the 3 Public Integrity Division Francesca Della Vecchia, 4 and Deputy Director Alycia Vasell. By letters dated April 28, 2023, Mayor 5 Eric Adams requested the advice and consent of the 6 7 Council regarding the appointments of Kenneth Chan, Sarah Kaufman, Paul Bader, and Thomas Sorrentino to 8 the New York Taxi and Limousine Commission. 9 Pursuant to Section 2301 of the Charter, 10 11 Paul Bader was recommended for appointment by the Queens Delegation to the Council, and Thomas 12 13 Sorrentino was recommended by the Brooklyn Delegation 14 to the Council. 15 On May 8th, the Committee held a public 16 hearing on all four nominations. Today, the Committee 17 will vote on whether to recommend to the Council 18 whether to provide its advice and consent to these 19 nominations. 20 We will vote on M149, the proposed 21 appointment by the Mayor of Kenneth Chan as a member 2.2 of the New York City Taxi and Limousine Commission to 23 serve the remainder of a seven-year term that expires 24 on January 31, 2024. 25

M150, the 5 proposed appointment by the Mayor of Paul Bader as a 6 7 member of the New York City Taxi and Limousine Commission to serve the remainder of a seven-year 8 9 term that expires on January 31, 2029, M151, the proposed appointment by the Mayor of Thomas 10 11 Sorrentino as a member of the New York City Taxi and 12 Limousine Commission to serve the remainder of a 13 seven-year term that expires on January 31, 2029, and 14 M152, the proposed appointment by the Mayor of Sarah 15 Kaufman as a member of the New York City Taxi and 16 Limousine Commission to serve the remainder of a 17 seven-year term that expires on January 31, 2026. 18 Before we vote, I want to invite any of 19 my Colleagues to offer any statements on the 20 nominations before us today. 21 Seeing none, the Clerk will now call the roll. 2.2 23 COMMITTEE CLERK WILLIAM MARTIN: Good morning.
