SERGEANT-AT-ARMS: Good morning and
welcome to the Committee on Rules, Privileges and Elections.

At this time, we ask if you could please place phones on vibrate or silent mode. Thank you. Chair, we are ready to begin.

CHAIRPERSON POWERS: Good morning and welcome to the meeting of the Committee on Rules, Privileges and Elections. I'm Council Member Keith Powers, Chair of the Committee.

Before we begin, I'd like to introduce the other Members of the Committee who are present here today. We are joined by Speaker Adrienne Adams, Minority Leader Joe Borelli, Justin Brannan, Council Member Gale Brewer, Council Member Selvena BrooksPowers, Council Member Crystal Hudson, Council Member Rafael Salamanca, Council Member Pierina Sanchez.

I'd like to acknowledge the Counsel of this Committee, Jeff Campagna, and Committee Staff that worked on the appointments we'll hear today. Public Integrity Division Francesca Della Vecchia, and Deputy Director Alycia Vasell.

By letters dated April 28, 2023, Mayor Eric Adams requested the advice and consent of the Council regarding the appointments of Kenneth Chan, Sarah Kaufman, Paul Bader, and Thomas Sorrentino to the New York Taxi and Limousine Commission.

Pursuant to Section 2301 of the Charter, Paul Bader was recommended for appointment by the Queens Delegation to the Council, and Thomas Sorrentino was recommended by the Brooklyn Delegation to the Council.

On May 8th, the Committee held a public hearing on all four nominations. Today, the Committee will vote on whether to recommend to the Council whether to provide its advice and consent to these nominations.

We will vote on M149, the proposed appointment by the Mayor of Kenneth Chan as a member of the New York City Taxi and Limousine Commission to serve the remainder of a seven-year term that expires on January 31, 2024.

Council Member Salamanca, can you mute yourself?

COUNCIL MEMBER SALAMANCA: I'm sorry.

CHAIRPERSON POWERS: Thank you. M150, the proposed appointment by the Mayor of Paul Bader as a member of the New York City Taxi and Limousine Commission to serve the remainder of a seven-year term that expires on January 31, 2029, M151, the proposed appointment by the Mayor of Thomas Sorrentino as a member of the New York City Taxi and Limousine Commission to serve the remainder of a seven-year term that expires on January 31, 2029, and M152, the proposed appointment by the Mayor of Sarah Kaufman as a member of the New York City Taxi and Limousine Commission to serve the remainder of a seven-year term that expires on January 31, 2026. Before we vote, $I$ want to invite any of my Colleagues to offer any statements on the nominations before us today.

Seeing none, the Clerk will now call the roll.
