2 joined today by Council Members Osse, Hudson, 3 Velazquez, Louis, Brooks-Powers, Barron, and Carr, 4 and Moya, and I think we're waiting for a few more on 5 Zoom.

This afternoon, the Committee will be 6 7 holding a hearing on Intro. 1051B sponsored by myself as well as Council Members Marte, Hudson, Farias, 8 9 Brewer, and Yeger. This bill would implement State legislation permitting the expansion of eligibility 10 11 for SCRIE, the Senior Citizen Rent Increase 12 Exemption, and the Disability Rent Increase 13 Exemption, or DRIE. Both of these programs serve 14 tenants of apartments in Battery Park City and apartments in former Article 2 Mitchell-Lama 15 16 buildings that are subject to rent regulation 17 agreements. It's well-known and understood that we 18 are in a housing crisis as a City and, as we work our 19 way out of this, we need every tool possible to 20 protect affordability and first and foremost keep people in their homes. In order to do that, their 21 homes have to be available, particularly when it 2.2 23 comes to vulnerable populations like our seniors and New Yorkers with disabilities. 24
