Today, we will vote to approve a rezoning proposal, Chair Salamanca told me to say that, and related special permit in my District in the Bronx.

The project is known as 893 Eagle Avenue Rezoning consisting of LUs 250, 251, and 252.

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We will also vote to approve with			
modifications LU 246 known as the Madison Square			
Garden Special Permit as well as the related			
application LU 245, the Arena Text Amendment, in			
Manhattan in Council Member Bottcher's District. For			
the reasons explained in the Council's resolution and			
the remarks that was made during the Zoning and			
Franchises Subcommittee meeting today, we are			
limiting the continued use of the Madison Square			
Garden as the arena to five additional years and			
condition this approval on a Transportation			
Management Plan to address the use conflicts between			
Madison Square Garden's current loading operation and			
pedestrian access to Penn Station.

Williams to give his remarks regarding this
