We're located in the Council Chambers. 6 Recording done by Rocco Mesiti. 7 SERGEANT-AT-ARMS: Good morning and welcome to today's New York City Council hearing for 8 9 the Committee on Environmental Protection, 10 Resiliency, and Waterfronts. 11 Please silence all cell phones and 12 electronic devices. 13 Chair, we're ready to begin. 14 CHAIRPERSON MENIN: [GAVEL] Good morning, 15 I'm Council Member Julie Menin filling in for Council Member James Gennaro, who is on Zoom and who is not 16 17 feeling well, I hope he feels better soon, so I am 18 serving as substitute Chair for the Committee on 19 Environmental Protection, Resiliency, and 20 Waterfronts. 21 Today, we will vote on Proposed Intro. 22 532-A, sponsored by Council Member Gennaro. We first 23 considered this bill on February 3rd of this year. 24 This bill seeks to bring all of the City's coastal 25 waters under the protection of the Federal

COMMITTEE ON ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION, RESILIENCY AND WATERFRONTS 3 Environmental Protection Agency by preparing them to be declared no discharge zones, in which both treated and untreated sewage discharge from vessels is prohibited.

To achieve this status, federal law 6 7 requires a body of water to host sufficient vessel 8 waste pump-out facilities. This bill would require 9 the Department of Environmental Protection, DEP, to report on the additional construction and 10 11 installation needed to establish the City's coastal bodies of water as no discharge zones and determine 12 13 how many pump-out facilities are necessary to achieve 14 that status.

15 DEP would be required to install at least 16 two pump-out facilities per year until each coastal 17 body of water hosts a number of operational pump-out 18 facilities DEP determines is required to achieve no 19 discharge zone status. This bill would also require 20 DEP to report every two years on its progress 21 regarding the foregoing and to make best efforts to 2.2 ensure that existing no discharge zones maintain 23 their status as no discharge zones once they are established. Achieving no discharge zone status for 24 all of our City's coastal bodies of water would bring 25

COMMITTEE ON ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION, RESILIENCY AND 1 WATERFRONTS our coastal waterways under federal protection and 2 3 lead to cleaner, healthier coastal waters for all New 4 Yorkers. I want to thank the terrific Committee 5 Staff who have done such great work over the years, 6 7 Committee Counsel Claire MacLachlan, Policy Analysts Ricky Chawla and Andrew Bourne, Financial Analysts 8 9 Tanveer Singh and Andrew Lane Lawless, and finally Council Member Gennaro's Legislative Director Nabjot 10 Kaur for all of their hard work. 11 I want to thank the following Council 12 13 Members who are here, Council Member Holden, Council 14 Member Restler, Council Member Nurse, Council Member 15 Gutiérrez. 16 Council Member Gennaro, did you want to 17 make a statement? 18 CHAIRPERSON GENNARO: Just very briefly. Thank you, Council Member Menin, for filling in. 19 20 Just the one item about the federal 21 protection. The goal is to get the Coast Guard and 2.2 the DEC, mostly the Coast Guard, would be in charge 23 of enforcing the no discharge mandate once it is fully established, and that's really the crux of what 24 we're going for here is to get the Coast Guard 25

COMMITTEE ON ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION, RESILIENCY AND 1 WATERFRONTS involved because they really will do enforcement as 2 3 opposed to DEP that does not have the capacity and, 4 DEC where I used to formerly work was nowhere near the capacity. 5 Once again, I thank you for filling in. I 6 7 am quite under the weather. Should I vote? I'll wait 8 until you call the roll. 9 CHAIRPERSON MENIN: Well, we certainly hope you feel better. 10 I will turn it to the Clerk to call the 11 roll call. 12 COMMITTEE CLERK WILLIAM MARTIN: Good 13 14 morning, William Martin. Feel better, Chair. 8 COMMITTEE CLERK WILLIAM MARTIN: Restler. 9 10 COUNCIL MEMBER RESTLER: Aye, and hope 11 you're doing okay, Jim. 12 COMMITTEE CLERK WILLIAM MARTIN: With a 13 vote of six in the affirmative, zero in the negative, and no abstentions, item has been adopted by the 14 15 Committee. CHAIRPERSON GENNARO: I want to thank my 16 17 Colleagues for their good wishes. I appreciate it. 18 CHAIRPERSON MENIN: Okay, that closes the 19 hearing. Thank you. [GAVEL] 20 21 22 23 24 25
