Intro. 349. This bill will make clarifying the edits
to Local Law 34 of 2024 to indicate that required
reports are to be submitted on a quarterly basis.

Local Law 34 requires that the Department of Social
Services in consultation with the NYPD, the
Department of Sanitation, and the Department of Parks

10	we, as a Council, need to ensure that these response
11	processes are delivering much-needed resources. By
12	increasing transparency through detailed quarterly
13	reporting, we can better understand the challenges
14	faced by those experiencing homelessness and
15	implement effective solutions to support them. Thank
16	you to Chair Ayala and my Colleagues for continuing
17	to work together to create a more exclusive and
18	supportive city for all individuals regardless of
19	their housing status, and I vote yes. Thank you.
