CHAIRPERSON ESPINAL: [GAVEL] Good afternoon. 4 My 5 name is Rafael Espinal. I am the Chair of the Consumer Affairs and Business Licensing Committee. 6 7 Today the committee will be holding a vote on preconsidered Into - it doesn't have a number yet. A 8 local law to amend the New York City Charter in 9 10 relation to adding members to the Nightlife Advisory Board. In the past several months, we have come a 11 12 long way in reforming our city's approach to 13 Nightlife. The last session repealed our Archaic 14 Cabaret Law and passed a law establishing the 15 Nightlife Office and the Nightlife Advisory Board. 16 Thank you Brad. I hope that this - with the 17 establishment of the Office of Nightlife and our 18 Nightlife Advisory Board we can begin a task of updating many more of our laws and regulations in 19 order to restore and enhance the city's nighttime 20 economy and think progressively about new ideas to 21 2.2 plan our city, so that nightlife goers, artists, 23 local residents, and the government can all communicate and live in harmony. The bill we are 24 25 voting on today represents a minor amendment to the
