CHAIRPERSON DROMM: Okay, good morning, and welcome to today's Finance Committee meeting. My name is Council Member Daniel Dromm, and I'm the Chair of the Committee. Today, we are joined by Council Member Steve Matteo, Council Member Rory Lancman, Council Member Andy Cohen, Council Member Keith Powers, Council Member Adrienne Adams, Council Member Robert Cornegy, Council Member Vanessa Gibson and Council Member Francisco Moya. Today, the committee will be voting on four items: preconsidered resolution related to the Hudson Yards Development in the Speaker's district, a transparency resolution and two Article XI property tax exemptions. First, we have the preconsidered resolution sponsored by the Speaker. This resolution would support an additional borrowing of up to \$500 million by the Hudson Yard's Infrastructure Corporation to complete the infrastructure projects in the Hudson Yard's Financing District including the Phase 2 of the project, which includes expansion of the Hudson Boulevard and park. The resolution would also support an undertaking by the city to pay current interest subject to appropriation to the

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2 extent not paid from revenues of HYIC on such HYIC indebtedness. Next we will-we have the transparency 3 resolution, which sets forth a new designation, and changes in the designation of certain organizations 5 6 receiving local, aging and youth discretionary 7 funding and funding pursuant to certain initiatives in the Budget. Organizations appearing in the 8 resolution that have not yet completed the 9 prequalification process conducted by the Mayor's 10 Office of Contract Services, the Council or another 11 12 entity are identified in the attached charts with an 13 asterisk. As with all transparency resolutions, Council Members will have to sign a disclosure form 14 15 indicating whether or not a conflict exists with any 16 of the groups on the attached list. If any Council Member has a potential conflict of interest with any 17 18 of the organizations listed, he or she has the opportunity to disclose the conflict at the time of 19 20 their vote. As a reminder, please disclose any conflicts you may have with the proposed 21 2.2 subcontractors used by organizations sponsored by 23 discretionary funding. These disclosures must be made before the subcontractor can be approved. 24 Benjamin Smith from the General Council's Office is 25

here, and can assist you with any questions or
concerns regarding disclosures. Next, we have the
Land Use items. The first is 526 West 158 th Street
in Council Member Levine's district in Manhattan,
which would provide a full 40-year Article XI tax
exemption to support the preservation of 29 units of
affordable co-op housing. The second is 941 Rogers
Place in Council Member Salamanca's district in the
Bronx, which would provide a full 40-year Article XI
tax exemption to support the preservation of 20 units
of affordable co-op housing. Both of these
properties were being considered for Round 10 of
HPD's Third-Party Transfer Program, and the approval
of these Article XI exemptions will mean that HDFC
co-op owners will get to retain the equity in their
homes. Both of the Council Members are supportive of
the projects in their districts. Those are all of
today's items. Are there any questions? I'll now
ask Billy Martin, Committee Clerk to call the roll.
