4	morning everyone. Welcome to the Committee on Land
5	use. I am Council Member Rafael Salamanca, Chair of
6	this-of this committee. Today, we've been joined by
7	our esteemed colleagues. We have Council Members
8	Constantinides, Chair Kallos, King, Miller, Reynoso,
9	Richards, Torres, Treyger, Grodenchik, Chair Adams,
10	Diaz, Chair Moya and Rivera. Today we'll voting on
11	an application that was referred out of our three
12	subcommittees. We will vote to approve LU 238, the
13	238 President Street House and LU 239 the Hans S.
14	Christian Memorial Kindergarten to historic landmark
15	designation by the Landmark Preservation Commission
16	located in Carroll Gardens neighborhood in Brooklyn
17	represented by Council Member Lander. We will vote
18	to approve with medication LU 256 the DOT Brooklyn
19	Fleet Service Application. The application pursuant
20	to Section 197-C of the New York City Charter is for
21	the site selection and acquisition of property
22	located at 25 $14^{th}$ Street in Brooklyn for a fleet
23	vehicle maintenance and repair facility. Because DOT
24	has committed to exploring sustainable energy systems
25	in this building our modification will clarify and
l	

2 assure that this site is for a DOT fleet not another agency's fleet. This site is also in Council Member 3 Lander's district. We will vote approve LU 278 an 4 application filed by the School Construction 5 Authority for the siting of a 456-seat intermediate 6 7 high school facility pursuant to Section 1732 of the Public Authorities Law, and the SCA seeks approval to 8 construct this building at 715 Ocean Terrace in 9 Council Member Matteo's district in Staten Island. 10 From our Zoning Subcommittee we will vote to approve 11 12 LU 267 an application by T&S Restaurant LLC for a 13 renewal of a revocable consent to operate and enclosed sidewalk café at Gracie's on Second Diner 14 located at 300 East 86<sup>th</sup> Street in Council Member 15 16 Kallos' district in Manhattan. We will also vote to 17 approve LU 268 an application from K.K.& D for 79<sup>th</sup> 18 Street Restaurant Corporation d/b/a Nectar Café for renewal of a revocable consent to operate an 19 20 unenclosed sidewalk café located at 1022 Madison Avenue in Council Member Power's district in 21 2.2 Manhattan. From our Planning Subcommittee, we will 23 vote to approve LU 257 Clinton URA site in Speaker Johnson's district in Manhattan, approval of a new 24 25 tax exemption pursuant to Article XI of the Private

2 Housing Finance Law would facilitate the completion of a project at 540 West 53<sup>rd</sup> Street consisting of 3 one residential building with 103 affordable dwelling 4 units, over 20,000 square foot of commercial space, 5 and about 2,500 square foot of open space. We will 6 7 vote to approve LU 258 at 590 Southern Boulevard in Council Member Ayala's district in the Bronx. 8 Approval of this tax exemption pursuant to Article XI 9 of the Private Housing Finance Law would facilitate 10 the preservation a 27-unit HDFC co-op that has been a 11 12 candidate for the third-party transfer round 10. HPD pulled the building from the third-party transfer 13 14 because of the progress that HDFC Board has made 15 towards resolving many outstanding issues. HPD is 16 seeking a new full tax exemption to address the outstanding real estate tax estate tax arrears. 17 We 18 will vote approve LU 265 JOE Central Brooklyn, an application pursuant to Article XI of the Private 19 20 Housing Finance Law for a tax exemptions applying to a jointly owned portfolio of 79 residential buildings 21 2.2 in Bedford-Stuyvesant and Brownsville neighborhoods 23 in Brooklyn. These building containing a total of 525 units are rental housing for low-income families 24 are in districts of Council Members Levin, Cumbo, 25

2 Cornegy, Ampry-Samuel and Barron. We will vote to approve LU 266, 464-68 West 51<sup>st</sup> Street, which 3 consists of two 5-story buildings providing 11 units 4 of homeownership buildings for low-income families in 5 the Tenson (sic) neighborhood of Manhattan in Speaker 6 7 Johnson's district. This is an application by HPD for a 30-year tax exemption pursuant to Article XI of 8 the Private Housing Finance Law. We will also vote 9 to approve LU 279, Victory Plaza for property located 10 at 3-11 West 118<sup>th</sup> Street and 1460-1472 Fifth Avenue 11 12 in Council Member Perkins' district in Manhattan. Approval of this for an amendment of to a previously 13 14 approved Urban Development Action Area Project will 15 facilitate the development of a new 9-story 135-unit, 100% affordable residential building for seniors. 16 Thirty percent of these units are reserved for 17 18 formerly home-for formerly homeless households. Are there any questions or remarks from members of the 19 20 Committee? Alright, seeing none, I will now call a vote in accordance with the recommendations of the 21 2.2 Subcommittees, and the local Council Members to 23 approve LUs 238, 239, 257, 258, 265, 266, 267, 268, 278 and 279 and to modify LU 256.
