At today's hearing the Committee will vote on Proposed Introduction 986-A sponsored by myself which will require an Agency that is obligated to transmit to the City Council copies of final audits, reports, evaluations or studies that contains data in a list, table, graph and chart to submit such data in a long propriety format that permits automated processing. The Committee originally held a hearing on this Bill on September 17th of this year. We heard from Government Groups, Civic Tech Groups and from others who rely on this data. This will make our Government more efficient and transparent.
