COUNCIL MEMBER MOYA: Thank you. wanted to say a few comments bout the bill that was just introduced, and I'm very proud of this bill, and as it would really go to provide drivers with the protection that they need, and not just to work and survive, but to live and thrive in our city. This bill will prevent predatory leases from overwhelming for-hire drivers with mountains of paperwork and really bad deals with subprime leases. It will also do so by allowing the TLC to create a Drivers Bill of Rights that's in line with our recommendations to provide a clear, plain language explanation of the lease, rental or conditional purchase agreements. This legislation is centered on protecting drivers at a time when they are in dire financial positions

COMMITTEE ON FORE-HIRE VEHICLES toward-to pushing them to grave and tragic decisions. I will continue to work hand-in-hand with the TLC to make sure drivers are protected from predatory dealers, and with that, I vote aye. CLERK: Final vote Committee on For-Hire Vehicles, Introductions 897-A and 1070-A, they're both adopted by the committee 6 in the affirmative, 0 on the negative and no abstentions.
