CHAIRPERSON DROMM: Okay, good morning, and welcome to today's Finance Committee meeting. name is Council Member Daniel Dromm, and I'm Chair of the committee. Today, we've been joined by Council Member Francisco Moya, Council Member Barry Grodenchik, Council Member Adrienne Adams, Council Member Jimmy Van Bramer, Council Member Andy Cohen, Council Member Steve Matteo, and we are expecting others shortly. Today, the committee will be voting two items, a transparency resolution and one Article XI Property Tax Exemption. First, we have the transparency resolution, which sets for the new designation and changes in t the designation of certain organizations to receiving local, aging and youth discretionary fund and funding pursuant to certain Initiatives in the Budget. Organizations appearing in the resolution that have not yet completed the prequalification process conducted by the Mayor's Office of Contract Services, the Council or another entity are identified in the attached chart with an asterisk. As will all transparency resolutions, Council Members will have to sign a

4	council member has a potential conflict of interest
5	with any of the organizations listed, he or she has
6	the opportunity to disclose the conflict at the time
7	of their vote. As a reminder, please disclose any
8	conflicts you may have with proposed subcontractors
9	used by organizations sponsored by discretionary
10	funding. These disclosures must be made before the
11	subcon-before the subcontractor can be approved.
12	Benjamin Smith from the General Counsel's office is
13	here, and can assist you with any questions or
14	concerns regarding disclosures. Next, we have on
15	land use item: Prospect Park Southwest is in Council
16	Member Eugene's district in Brooklyn, which-which
17	would provide a partial 30-year Article XI property
18	tax exemption to support the preservation of 394
19	units of affordable rental housing. Council Member
20	Eugene is supportive of the project. Those are all
