COUNCIL MEMBER YEGER: Okay. thank you, Mr. Chairman. I'll just need a second. The whole Parks thing threw me off. So, I'm just getting my notes ready.

that what that it was. Mr. Chairman, thank you very much. I support this bill, and I intend to vote for here in committee today. However, as I understand it the agenda of the Council will have this bill appear on it for today's Stated. At today's Stated I will not be able to vote in favor of this bill for the following reason: The bill, as I understand, did not lay on the desks properly in accordance with Section 36 of the Charter. The Charter requires that bills in this Council in order for them to be—to be adopted by the full Council have to lay on the desks of the members of the Council seven days prior to adoption. When we walked into this room Wednesday for the Stated, the desks of the members of the Council look

like they do right now, not a single piece of paper Now, it's possible sure in theory that of on them. bills were put on the desks for Tuesday night prior to midnight, and then a band of eager chipmunks came in and stole them off the desks, but when we walked in here on Wednesday, there was not a single paper on the desks of the members of this Council. That's not just my opinion, and it's not just my presentation of facts, but it's fully backed up by viewing the video of the Stated Meeting of this body that was held last Wednesday when we adopted the budget. You can look at the desks. You can see there's no paper on it. Now, again, as I said it's possible the papers were put on the desks Tuesday night, and then subsequently removed. I don't know what happened, but I will not be able to vote for it later today. However, I commend the Chair because this bill an important bill, and what I would prefer is that the bill be laid over after-after being recommended out of this committee and reported to the Council, but not being voted on today by the Stated, but being voted on at a subsequent Stated, and with that, thank you, Mr. Chairman. I vote aye.
