CHAIRPERSON MENCHACA: Buenos dias, We are beginning our Immigration everyone. Committee voting and I want to welcome everyone. name is Carlos Menchaca. I'm the Chair of the New York City Council's committee on Immigration. the Committee on Immigration will be holding a second hearing and a vote on a package of legislation drafted in response to the Federal Administration's new rule regarding inadmissibility on public charge grounds. Some version of a Public Charge Rule ahs been in the news for more than 18 months. At the City Council here we have the threat of an expended Public Charge Rule very seriously. We consider it our responsibility as Council Members to use out legislative authority to respond thoughtfully to the needs of our constituents, and this city is a city for all—all New Yorkers. Regardless of your background you belong here, and that is why the committee is voting today on a package of legislation that will ensure that correct information about the rule and existing city supports is discriminated as quickly and efficiently as possible.
