Introduced by Council Member Brannan.

A LOCAL LAW

To amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to prohibiting street vending on certain streets in Dyker Heights in Brooklyn beginning on Thanksgiving until New Year's Day

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Section 17-315 of the administrative code of the city of New York is amended by adding a new paragraph 3 to read as follows:

3. No food vendor shall vend beginning on Thanksgiving until New Year's Day of the following year in the area including and bounded on the west by the westerly side of 10th avenue, on the south by the southerly side of 86th street, on the east by the easterly side of 13th avenue and on the north by the northerly side of 81st street, between the hours of midnight to 6:00 a.m. and between the hours of 2:00 p.m. to midnight, in the borough of Brooklyn.

§ 2. Subdivision g of section 20-465 of the administrative code of the city of New York is amended by adding a new paragraph 5 to read as follows:

(5) No general vendor shall vend beginning on Thanksgiving until New Year's Day of the following year in the area including and bounded on the west by the westerly side of 10th avenue, on the south by the southerly side of 86th street, on the east by the easterly side of 13th avenue and

on the north by the northerly side of 81st street, between the hours of midnight to 6:00 a.m. and between the hours of 2:00 p.m. to midnight, in the borough of Brooklyn.

§ 3. This local law takes effect immediately.
