CHAIRPERSON CABRERA: Good morning and welcome to this second hearing and vote of the City Council's Committee on Governmental Operations. I am Chair Fernando Cabrera. Today's-today the committee will vote on one bill sponsored by myself. Proposed Intro 991-C would authorize the Office of Administrative Trials and Hearings to dismiss a violation enforced by the Taxi and Limousine Commission pertaining to defective vehicle lights so long as two conditions are met. First, the driver or owner must fix the light no later than one day after being issued a violation, and second, the driver must provide proof of correction such as the Statement of Correction issued by the State Inspection Authority or auto repair shop along with the TLC summons to the TLC. One the TLC upon inspection of proof determines that the driver or owner corrected the light, it will then recommend that OATH dismiss the violation. saves drivers from having to pay the ticket or waste hours that could have spent driving on an OATH I want to thank our committee staff Daniel hearing.
