- Vision Zero: Reduction of \$7.1 million in FY21 in public awareness campaign, protected bike lanes, and markings and other materials.
- Better Bus Initiative: Reduction of \$5.7 million in FY 21, including funding reduction for transit signal priority (TSP) and bus lane improvements.
- SI Ferry Overnight Service Reduction: Savings of \$4.9 million in FY21 capital funding
- Parking Meter Upgrade Delay: Savings of \$3.2 million in FY21
- Vacancy Reduction: Reduction of \$1.8 million in FY21
- Reduce Expense \$ for Capitally Ineligible Components of Projects: Savings of \$1 million in FY21
- Cut Lower Level Boarding on SI Ferry: Savings of \$909,000 in FY21

Capital Budget

- \$10.3 billion: 5-Year Capital Plan
- (\$487.9 million): Variance in Executive Plan compared to Prelim Plan
- Majority of this funding was not cut, but shifted beyond the plan years

- \$17.4 billion: 10-Year Capital Plan
- (\$75 million): Variance in Executive 10-Year Capital Plan compared to Preliminary Ten-Year Capital Plan
- Majority of variance in 5-Year Plan is reflected in 10-year plan
