everyone, and thank you for coming. I am Council member Robert Cornegy, Chair of the Council's Committee on Housing and Buildings. We are here to vote on a bill related to extending the city's rent stabilization Law. Pursuant to state law, the city must conduct the housing and vacancy survey every three years. This survey is conducted by HPD in collaboration with the United States Census Bureau and would ordinarily be conducted this year for completion by the current deadline of April 1st, 2021. However, during the year that the decennial census, like 2020, the Census Bureau has limited capacity to assist HPD in gathering and analyzing data. Recognizing the Census Bureau's limited
