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COUNCIL MEMBER BARRON: Thank you. As this the Committee on Landmarks, and we're often times offering information about the architectural structure designs a uniqueness, I want to just highlight that regarding LU 703. There is a significant architectural design on the exterior of the building, which is commonly known as a cartouche is a hyroglass, and hieroglyphic symbol, and it's an oval with a horizontal line at the bottom and it encloses text or other pictures in the cartouche outlines, and the cartouche is framed there, and the cartouche was actually a name that was essentially the symbol. From the Egyptian history it was known as a sanu, but the French soldiers that came over called it a cartouche because that was a word that they used for the materials that held the ammunition, and it looked like that to them, the shape of that. So, I just wanted to put that on the record. It also is important to put them to the context, particularly historical context as we're talking about landmarks and with that, I vote age on all on all. Thank you. (bell)
