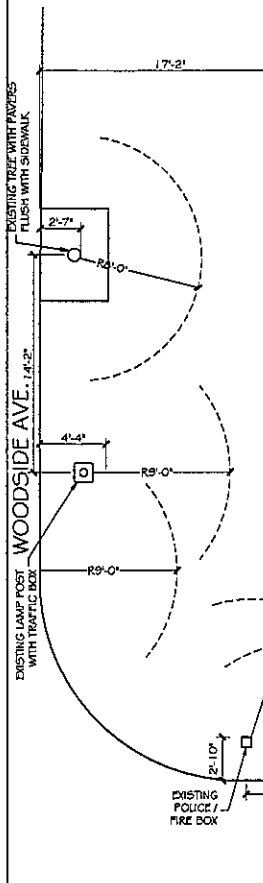
1 PROPOSED ELEVATION

NOTE

1. THE EXTERIOR CORNERS OF THE BORDER OF THE SPACE AUTHORIZED TO BE OCCUPIED BY AN UNENCLOSED SIDEWALK CAFE SHALL BE MARKED ON THE SIDEWALK BY A LINE PAINTED WITH WHITE LATEX TRAFFIC AND ZONE MARKING PAINT. THE LINE AT THE OUTSIDE CORNER SHALL BE (A) 1" WIDE AND EITHER: (1) BE 3' LONG ON EACH SIDE OF THE CAFE BORDER FROM THE POINT WHERE THE BORDERS INTERSECT AT AN ANGLED CORNER, OR (B) MARK THE ENTIRE ARC OF A CURVED CORNER FROM THE POINT WHERE THE ARC INTERSECTS WITH THE STRAIGHT PORTION OF THE SIDEWALK CAFE BORDER.

3. NO BEER, ALCOHOLIC OR SPIRITIOUS LIQUORS SHALL BE SERVED ON THE SIDEWALK CAFE PREMISES OR AT ANY TABLE THEREON, UNLESS PERMITTED UNDER A LICENSE ISSUED BY THE NEW YORK STATE LIQUOR AUTHORITY.
4. A SIMPLE MENU NO LARGER THAN THREE SQUARE FEET MAY BE POSTED IN THE SIDEWALK CAFE, SO THAT IT MAY BE READ FROM THE STREET.

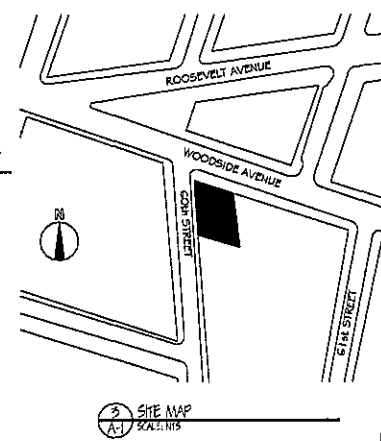

My name is Lisa Deller and I am Chair of the Community Board 2, Queens Land Use Committee. Our Committee has been working on this application since December 2019. During review of their renewal application, the applicant certified that there had been no changes since their last renewal and the rendering did not include the tree pit and muni meter obstructions. My testimony includes the following timeline and documents.

December 12, 2019 – CB2 received notice from DCA of Renewal Application and we invited the applicant to present their renewal to the Land Use Committee of CB2 (attached)

December 18th – Mr. Delane and Mr. O’Sullivan attended the Land Use Committee Meeting (see below item from CB2 meeting minutes 12/18/19 and attached)

This is an application for a renewal of an unenclosed sidewalk café with 15 tables and 30 seats at Sean Og’s Restaurant located at 60-02 Woodside Avenue, Woodside, NY

Paul Delane, and James O’Sullivan introduced themselves and provided the following update

- Operating since 2009
- They have been in Woodside for 21 years.

Ms. Deller stated the barrier around the café is overshooting the parameters for the café. It needs to be inside the square not into the sidewalk area. She also discussed the tree pit which is creating an obstruction for pedestrians. Ms. Deller requested they put a metal grate over the tree pit.

Ms. Deller suggested they go back to speak to their architect about the measurements and then come back to the Community Board in January. As it is now, there are obstructions there and the café exceeds the dimensions that were approved and there isn’t sufficient pedestrian walkway.

A board member stated that the applicant signed a certificate of no change, which states the public sidewalk immediately adjacent to the premises has remained unchanged since the date of the most recently approved sidewalk café plans on file including that no new fixed objects have been placed on the sidewalk within 20 feet of the sidewalk café.

The certificate of change is incorrect and on the page of affirmation for penalty for false statements that there is a fine of up to 1000.

It was recommended that they request an extension to put off the application until these things are corrected and to ask for an extension so that CB 2 has a chance to make our decision.

Lisa Deller made a motion and it was seconded by Stephen Cooper to oppose the application as their café overstep the parameters of the approved application and things have changed on the street. All were in favor by a show of hands with none opposed and no abstentions.

January 10, 2020

- Debra Markell, CB2 – called Sean Og's and they said that that would not be ready with a revised café plan.
- Sean Og said they would not be ready until February, they will probably attend in February.

January 15, 2020 – Applicant was unable to attend Land Use Meeting

January 27, 2020 – Letter sent to DCA to oppose the Sean Og application for a renewal of a sidewalk café (attached) The CB has 45 days to review an Application they frequently will approve applications without further CB involvement. Referral to the City Council Land Use Committee is a rare event and we greatly appreciate this hearing.

February 13, 2020 – CB2 received revised plans from Sean Og's increasing the table from 15 to 19 and moving table to Woodside Ave. (attached)

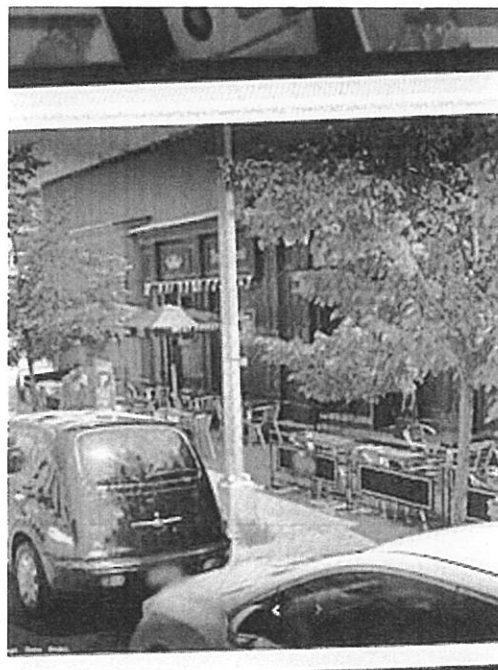
February 21, 2020 – DCA Revocable Consent Agreement dated February 13th, granting consent to the Café received by CB2 (attached)

February 26, 2020 – email from Paul from Sean Og's that due to vacation he was unable to attend the Feb meeting and he wanted to meet before the next Land Use Meeting to discuss the Application.

February 27, 2020 – CB2 notified by CM Van Bramer that the Application would be heard on March 11, 2020 at the City Council Land Use Committee

March 16, 2020 – CB2 Land Use Chair phone call with architect and owners of Sean Og's regarding revised café plan. Team agreed to attend March 18, 2020 Land Use Meeting.

To Whom It May Concern:

On December 18, 2019, the Land Use Committee of Community Board 2, Queens met to review the application for an unenclosed sidewalk café for Sean OG Enterprises LLC located at 60-02 Woodside Avenue, Woodside, New York.

At that meeting, with a quorum present, a motion was made and seconded to oppose the application for 15 tables and 30 seats. A photo, which the owners presented, showed that the café barrier fence had exceeded the approved sidewalk space allocated for the café. In addition, the application stated that there were no obstructions on the sidewalk and that the sidewalk conditions had not changed, which is contrary to the actual condition. The City has added muni meters and there are currently two tree pit obstructions adjacent to the café. This inaccurate statement would have the applicant be subject to a fine for knowingly misrepresenting the streetscape.

The vote was all in favor to oppose the application; with none opposed and no abstentions.
