3 CHAIR ALICKA AMPRY-SAMUEL: Good morning, 4 everyone, and thank you for coming. I am Council 5 Member Alicka Ampry-Samuel, Chair of the Council's 6 Committee on Public Housing. We are here to vote on Proposed Intro Number 2330-A, sponsored Council 8 Member Cabrera in relation to New York City Housing 9 Authority complaints and request for service. 10 Bill was originally heard by the committee on June 11 16th, this year. This legislation would require the 12 3-1-1 customer service center to accept complaints or 13 service requests about NYCHA in the same way it 14 routinely does for any other poll. This would add 15 transparency, accountability, and fairness to the way 16 NYCHA residents are able to bring complaints and 17 service request. First, NYCHA residents would be 18 able to register their complaints with 3-1-1 just 19 like any other New Yorkers would be to, and second, 20 3-1-1 would be required to publish information about 21 these complaints just as it does with any other 2.2 complaint it receives. I'd like to commend my colleague, Council Member Fernando Cabrera for 23 24 sponsoring this legislation and working to improve 25 the lives of our city's public housing residents. Ι
