4	going to start the Health Committee hearing. Good
5	morning, everyone. I am Mark Levine, Chair of the
6	City Council's Health Committee. Welcome to our
7	hearing this morning. I am pleased that we are
8	joined by fellow Health Committee members, Council
9	Member Alicka Ampry-Samuel, Council Member Brooks,
LO	Council Member Dr. Eugene, Council Member Holden, and
L1	also Council Member Keith Power, I believe is a
L2	member of our committee. Did I miss any other
L3	committee members? I think we got it. Oh, Council
L4	Member Diaz as well hiding in the back. Well, if

L7	we're going to be holding an important vote on
L8	Proposed Intro 2373-A by Council Member Rafael
L9	Salamanca which amends the Administrative code of the
20	city of New York in relation to amending a transcript
21	of a record of death caused by COVID-19. The Bill
22	would require that the Department of Health and
23	Mental Hygiene to wave any fee for applicants
24	requesting to amend a death certificate to list the
2.5	cause of death as COVID-19 or health complications

you, Mr. Chair, and I want to thank the Health

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Committee. Like thousands and thousands of New
Yorkers in April of 2020, I lost my dad to COVID-19,
and when I received his death certificate, I realized
that under reason for death, it was natural causes.
I really didn't pay any mind to it until the Federal
Government, FEMA has an assistance where individuals
can apply to get some reimbursement for funeral
experiences, and I was getting calls from
constituents who were dealing with the same issue
where their death certificate just said natural
causes, and so, as a result, FEMA was just not
approving their application. So, I think that this
go a real long way when I looked into fixing my dad,
correcting my dad's death certificate, there was a
\$40 fee. You know, I am blessed that I am able to
afford it, but there are hundreds and hundreds of New
Yorkers which a \$40 fee is a burden on them, and many
of them may forego fixing their family member's death
certificate just because they don't have the \$40.
So, I really want to thank the Health Committee
Counsel and you, Mr. Chair for helping me push this
Bill through.
