A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to the enforcement of etching acid legislation.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Section 20-616 of the administrative code of the city of New York, as added by local law number 30 for the year 2009, is amended to read as follows:

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§20-616 Penalties. 1. Any person who violates the provisions of this [section] <u>subchapter</u> shall be guilty of a violation punishable by a fine of not less than one hundred dollars and not more than two hundred fifty dollars.

- 2. Any person violating this [section] <u>subchapter</u> shall be subject to a civil penalty of not less than one hundred dollars and not more than two hundred fifty dollars. A proceeding to recover any civil penalty pursuant to this section shall be commenced by the service of a notice of hearing that shall be returnable to the administrative tribunal of the department.
- 3. Any person who subsequently violates this [section] <u>subchapter</u> within a period of one year of the date of the first violation shall be guilty of a violation, punishable by a fine <u>of</u> not less than five hundred dollars.
- §2. This local law shall take effect on the same date that local law number 30 for the year 2009 takes effect.
