Whereas, bills have been introduced in the New York State Legislature by Senator Padavan, S.7830, and Assembly Member Abbate, A.10182, "AN ACT to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to the twenty year retirement program established for members of the New York city employees' retirement system employed as investigators by district attorneys' offices"; and

Whereas, the enactment of the above State Legislation requires the concurrence of the Council of the City of New York as the local legislative body; now, therefore, be it
