A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to the identification of dog owners by sanitation agents

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 1 of title 16 of the administrative code of the city of New York is amended by adding

a new section 16-133.1 to read as follows:

§ 16-133.1 Identification of dog owner. Any peace officer of the department of sanitation enforcing

section 1310 of the public health law shall have available a device capable of reading the identification information contained in a microchip implanted in a dog.

§ 2. This local law takes effect 120 days after it becomes law, provided that the commissioner of sanitation may take any actions necessary prior to such effective date for the implementation of this local law including, but not limited to, establishing guidelines and promulgating rules.
