A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to extending the prohibition of certain telephone order charges by third-party food delivery services

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

File #: Int 2356-2021, Version: A

Section 1. Subdivision b of section 20-847 of the administrative code of the city of New York, as

amended by local law number 87 for the year 2020, is amended to read as follows:

b. The requirements of this section apply only [during the period in which a state disaster emergency

has been declared by the governor of the state of New York or a state of emergency has been declared by the

mayor, such declaration is in effect in the city, and all food service establishments in the city are prohibited

from operating at the maximum indoor occupancy and for a period of 90 days thereafter] until February 17,

<u>2022</u>.

§ 2. This local law takes effect immediately, except that if it becomes law after August 17, 2021, it shall

be retroactive to and deemed to have been in effect on and after August 17, 2021.
