Whereas, bills have been introduced in the New York State Legislature by Senator Padavan, S.5357, and Assembly Member Lafayette, A.8038, "AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law and the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to increasing the number of intersections where traffic-control signal photo violation-monitoring systems and relating to the civil liability of vehicle owners for traffic-control signal violations"; and
