A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to tracking certifications of minority and women owned business enterprises and emerging business enterprises

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph 1 of subdivision 1 of section 6-129 of the administrative code of the city of New

York is amended by adding new subparagraphs (e-1) and (e-2) to read as follows:

(e-1) the number of firms certified as MBEs or WBEs as of the final day of the quarter compared to the

number of firms found to be available in the most recent review conducted pursuant to subparagraph (a) of

paragraph 4 of subdivision d of this section for each industry classification, and the percentage increases in the

numbers of such certified firms reported for the immediately preceding quarter;

(e-2) the number of firms certified as EBEs as of the final day of the quarter and the percentage increase

in the numbers of such certified firms reported for the immediately preceding quarter;

§ 2. This local law takes effect 120 days after it becomes law, except that the commissioner of small

business services and the city chief procurement officer, as such term is defined in paragraph 7 of subdivision c

of section 6-129 of the administrative code of the city of New York, may take all actions necessary for its

implementation before such effective date.
