Whereas, bills have been introduced in the New York State Legislature by Senator Maltese, S.2028-A, and Assembly Member Seminerio, A.4426-A, "AN ACT to amend the retirement and social security law and the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to permitting certain New York city correction members to borrow from their accumulated member contributions and to repeal certain provisions of the retirement and social security law relating thereto"; and
