A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to prohibiting the city of New York from contracting with entities engaged in immigration enforcement

## Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 1 of title 6 of the administrative code of the city of New York is amended by adding

a new section 6-122 to read as follows:

§ 6-122 Contracts with entities engaged in immigration enforcement prohibited. a. The city shall not

provide any good to, or perform any service for, an entity engaged in immigration enforcement, as defined in

subdivision a of section 10-178, in return for any monetary or in-kind payment.

b. This section applies to all contracts in effect on or after the effective date of this section.

§ 2. This local law takes effect 60 days after it becomes law.
