A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to reporting of data related to COVID-19

## Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Section 1. Chapter 1 of title 17 of the administrative code of the city of New York is amended

by adding a new section 17-199.19 to read as follows:

**City Council** 

§ 17-199.19 Reporting on COVID-19. a. Definitions. For the purposes of this section, the term "COVID

-19" means the disease caused by the severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2 (SARS-CoV-2).

b. The department shall maintain a website where it reports and updates daily the following information

for each zip code:

## 1. The number of tests for COVID-19 performed;

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- 2. The number of COVID-19 tests that were positive;
- 3. The percentage of COVID-19 tests that were positive;
- 4. The number of COVID-19 vaccines administered; and
- 5. The number of deaths due to COVID-19.
- c. The information reported pursuant to subdivision b shall be posted on the website no later than seven

days following the date the department receives such data.

§ 2. This local law takes effect immediately.

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
