Whereas, bills have been introduced in the New York State Legislature by Senator Golden, S.7239-A, and Assembly Member Abbate, A.10273-A, "AN ACT to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, and the retirement and social security law, in relation to the pensions of registered nurse and midwife members of the New York city employees' retirement system"; and

Whereas, the enactment of the above State Legislation requires the concurrence of the Council of the City of New York as the local legislative body; now, therefore, be it
