A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to increasing the fines for commercial vehicles that park on residential streets.

### Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph 2 of subdivision c of Section 19-170 of the administrative code of the city of New York is amended to read as follows:

2. A first violation of this section, when the commercial vehicle is a tractor-trailer combination, tractor, truck trailer or semi-trailer, shall be punishable by a monetary fine of [two hundred fifty] <u>five hundred</u> dollars. Any such subsequent violation of this section by the same owner, as defined in paragraph a of subdivision one of section two hundred thirty-nine of the vehicle and traffic law, within a six month period shall be punishable by a monetary fine of [five hundred] <u>seven hundred and fifty</u> dollars. <u>Any third violation by the same owner, as</u>

defined in paragraph a of subdivision one of section two hundred thirty-nine of the vehicle and traffic law, within a year of the first violation shall be punishable by a monetary fine of one thousand dollars.

§2. This local law shall take effect ninety days after it shall have been enacted into law.
