Security law to ensure that all State and City elected officials, judges and agency heads who are hired in the future and who are later convicted of or plead guilty to serious criminal conduct in connection with their State or City employment will be prohibited from collecting the publicly funded portion of their pension, or, alternatively, to grant the City the authority to enact legislation prohibiting City elected officials, judges and agency heads who are hired in the future and who are later convicted of or plead guilty to serious criminal conduct in connection with their City employment from collecting the

publicly funded portion of their pension.
