State Legislation Resolution No. 109

State Legislation Resolution requesting the New York State Legislature to pass bills introduced by Senator Golden, S.4713-A, and Assembly Member Abbate, A.7613-A, “AN ACT to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to the establishment of a twenty year retirement program for members of the New York city employees’ retirement system employed as emergency medical technicians and advanced emergency medical technicians (paramedics); and to amend the retirement and social security law, in relation to the establishment of twenty year retirement programs for such members who are subject to articles 11 and 15 of such law”.

Whereas, bills have been introduced in the New York State Legislature by Senator Golden, S.4713-A, and Assembly Member Abbate, A.7613-A, “AN ACT to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to the establishment of a twenty year retirement program for members of the New York city employees’ retirement system employed as emergency medical technicians and advanced emergency medical technicians (paramedics); and to amend the retirement and social security law, in relation to establishment of twenty year retirement programs for such members who are subject to articles 11 and 15 if such law”; and

Resolved, that the Council of the City of New York, in accordance with the provisions of Section 2 of Article 9 of the Constitution of the State of New York, does hereby request the New York State Legislature to enact into law the aforesaid pending bills.
