State Legislation Resolution No. 116

State Legislation Resolution requesting the New York State Legislature to pass bills introduced by Senator Smith, S.7910, and Assembly Member Cook, A.11361, “AN ACT authorizing the city of New York to reconvey its interest in certain real property acquired by in rem tax foreclosure in the borough of Queens to former owner Morris Brown Church, notwithstanding expiration of the two year period within which application may be made to the city release its interest in property thus acquired; Block No. 12048, Lot No. 85 on tax map for the borough of Queens”.

Whereas, bills have been introduced in the New York State Legislature by Senator Smith, S.7910, and Assembly Member Cook, A.11361, “AN ACT authorizing the city of New York to reconvey its interest in certain real property acquired by in rem tax foreclosure in the borough of Queens to former owner Morris Brown Church, notwithstanding expiration of the two year period within which application may be made to the city release its interest in property thus acquired; Block No. 12048, Lot No. 85 on tax map for the borough of Queens”; and
