State Legislation Resolution No. 135

State Legislation Resolution requesting the New York State Legislature to pass bills introduced by the Senate Committee on Rules, S.5617, and Assembly Member Farrell, A.8780, “AN ACT to amend the tax law, the administrative code of the city of New York, chapter 877 of the laws of 1975, chapter 880 of the laws of 1975, chapter 884 of the laws of 1975, and chapter 882 of the laws of 1977, all relating to the imposition of certain taxes in the city of New York, in relation to postponing the expiration of certain tax rates and taxes in the city of New York”.

Whereas, bills have been introduced in the New York State Legislature by the Senate Committee on Rules, S.5617, and Assembly Member Farrell, A.8780, “AN ACT to amend the tax law, the administrative code of the city of New York, chapter 877 of the laws of 1975, chapter 880 of the laws of 1975, chapter 884 of the laws of 1975, and chapter 882 of the laws of 1977, all relating to the imposition of certain taxes in the city of New York, in relation to postponing the expiration of certain tax rates and taxes in the city of New York”; and

Resolved, that the Council of the City of New York, in accordance with the provisions of Section 2 of Article 9 of the Constitution of the State of New York, does hereby request the New York State Legislature to enact into law the aforesaid pending bills.
