State Legislation Resolution No. 126

State Legislation Resolution requesting the New York State Legislature to pass a bill introduced by Assembly Member Heastie, A.4407, “AN ACT authorizing the city of New York to discontinue the use as parkland a portion of real property in the borough of the Bronx and to use such property, as well as property under the jurisdiction of the city of New York department of transportation, for expansion and improvement of the Gun Hill Road subway station, in and around the intersection of White Plains Road and Gun Hill Road in exchange for the dedication of certain other land in the borough of the Bronx for park purposes”.

Whereas, a bill has been introduced in the New York State Legislature by Assembly Member Heastie, A.4407 “AN ACT authorizing the city of New York to discontinue use as parkland a portion of real property in the borough of the Bronx and to use such property, as well as property under the jurisdiction of the city of New York department of transportation, for expansion and improvement of the Gun Hill Road subway station, in and around the intersection of White Plains Road and Gun Hill Road in exchange for the dedication of certain other land in the borough of the Bronx for park purposes”; and

Whereas, the enactment of the above State Legislation requires the concurrence of the Council of the City of New York as the local legislative body; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, that the Council of the City of New York, in accordance with the provisions of Section 2 of Article 9 of the Constitution of the State of New York, does hereby request the New York State Legislature to enact into law the aforesaid pending bill.
