State Legislation Resolution No. 105

State Legislation Resolution requesting the New York State Legislature to pass bills introduced by the Senate Committee on Rules, S.5437, and Assembly Member Abbate, A.8245, “AN ACT to amend the retirement and social security law and the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to the establishment of a twenty-five year/age fifty-five retirement program for members of the New York city employees’ retirement system employed as a mortuary/quality assurance member subject to articles 11 and 15 of the retirement and social security law”.

Whereas, bills have been introduced in the New York State Legislature by the Senate Committee on Rules, S.5437, and Assembly Member Abbate, A.8245, “AN ACT to amend the retirement and social security law and the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to the establishment of a twenty-five year/age fifty-five retirement program for members of the New York city employees’ retirement system employed as a mortuary/quality assurance member subject to articles 11 and 15 of the retirement and social security law”; and

Whereas, the enactment of the above State Legislation requires the concurrence of the Council of the City of New York as the local legislative body; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, that the Council of the City of New York, in accordance with the provisions of Section 2 of Article 9 of the Constitution of the State of New York, does hereby request the New York State Legislature to enact into law the aforesaid pending bills.
