A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to requiring the department

for the aging to report annually on senior centers within public housing developments

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Paragraphs 1, 10 and 11 of subdivision c of section 21-208 of the administrative code of the

city of New York, as added by local law number 140 for the year 2018, are amended to read as follows:

1. The program name, sponsor name, address, New York city housing authority development in which

such senior center is located if such senior center is located on property owned by the housing authority,

borough, council district, community district, designation as a neighborhood senior center or innovative senior

center, and days and hours of operation as well as such information for each affiliated site;

10. The total number of employees, disaggregated by full-time and part-time employees; [and]

11. The total budgeted amount for personnel services[.];

§ 2. Subdivision c of section 21-208 of the administrative code of the city of New York is amended by

adding new paragraphs 12, 13 and 14 to read as follows:

12. For each senior center located on property owned by the New York city housing authority, the name

of the entity that operates such senior center;

13. To the extent practicable, for each senior center located on property owned by such authority, the

number of complaints related to such senior center's facilities; and

14. To the extent such information is available, any steps taken to address the complaints described in

paragraph 13 of this subdivision.

§ 3. This local law takes effect immediately, provided, however, that the amendments to section 21-208

of the administrative code of the city of New York made by sections one and two of this law shall not affect the

repeal of such section 21-208 pursuant to local law number 140 for the year 2018.
