A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to limiting the duration of street resurfacing projects.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Section 19-115 of the administrative code of the city of New York is amended to read as

follows:

§ 19-115 Paving, generally. All streets shall be paved and arched in full accordance with department

specifications for such work, which shall be prescribed by the commissioner and kept on file in his or her office

[.], provided that for street resurfacing projects, paving shall be completed within two weeks of the completion

of milling. The commissioner may extend such time period to accommodate delays caused by weather.

§ 2. This local law shall take effect 90 days after enactment.
