A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to purchase of zero emission heavy duty trucks

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Subchapter 7 of chapter 1 of title 24 of the administrative code of the city of New York is

amended by adding a new subdivision i to section 24-163.4 to read as follows:

i. Zero emission heavy-duty trucks. As used in this section:

The term "heavy-duty trucks" means trucks in vehicle class 5 or above weighing at least 19,000 pounds.

The term "zero emission vehicle" includes electric vehicles including battery, fuel cell and catenary

operated vehicles that do not generate any emissions.

1. By no later than December 31, 2019, the commissioner shall direct that all heavy-duty trucks

purchased or leased by the city be zero emission vehicles such that by January 1, 2025 at least 15 percent of all

the new heavy-duty vehicles purchased or leased by the city shall be zero emission heavy duty vehicles.

2. By no later than December 31, 2025, the commissioner shall direct that all heavy-duty trucks purchased or leased by the city be zero emission vehicles such that by January 1, 2030 at least 30 percent of all new heavy-duty vehicles purchased or leased by the city shall be zero emission heavy-duty vehicles.

§ 2. This local law takes effect ninety days after it becomes law.
