A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to permitting food vending and general vending on certain streets

## Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision k of section 17-315 of the administrative code of the city of New York is

amended by adding a new paragraph 3 to read as follows:

3. A food vendor may vend on specified portions of the following streets, provided that such food

vendor complies with all applicable laws and rules:

(a) The easterly side of Broadway between Exchange Place and Beaver Street.

§ 2. Subdivision g of section 20-465 of the administrative code of the city of New York is amended by adding a new paragraph (5) to read as follows:

(5) A general vendor may vend on specified portions of the following streets, provided that such general

vendor complies with all applicable laws and rules:

(a) The easterly side of Broadway between Exchange Place and Beaver Street.

§ 3. This local law takes effect 60 days after it becomes law.
