A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to parental notification of unexpected absences in day care services

Be it enacted by the Council as follows: Section 1. Chapter 13 of title 17 of the administrative code of

the city of New York is amended by adding a new section 17-1305.1 to read as follows:

§ 17-1305.1 Notification of absence. a. When any child is absent without notice from a child care

service, such child care service shall notify the parent or legal guardian of such child's absence within one hour

of the child's scheduled time of arrival by telephone, text or email message or other means of immediate

communication. When such parent or legal guardian cannot be reached or does not respond within 30 minutes

of such immediate communication, the child care service must make at least three attempts to notify at least

two emergency contacts listed in such child's file, and shall maintain a record of having made such attempts in

the log required by section 47.29 (e) of the New York city health code.

§ 2. This local law takes effect 120 days after it becomes law, except that the commissioner may take

such actions as are necessary to implement this local law, including the promulgation of rules, before such date.
